The Training Centre

The Auckland Training Centre for Psychodrama (ATCP) is an educational trust. It is accredited by the Australian and New Zealand Psychodrama Association Inc (ANZPA). ATCP provides training leading to certification as a practitioner of Psychodrama, Sociodrama, Sociometry and Role Training.

ATCP's curriculum and practice is governed by ANZPA's Code of Ethics, and Training and Standards Manual. The work of the training centre is an integral aspect of ANZPA and its local region, ANZPA Northern. This brochure describes ATCP's vision, purpose, and training options for 2009 provided in Auckland, Hamilton and Tauranga by a team of accredited Trainer Educator Practitioners (TEPs) and TEPs in Training.

The Purpose of Training

Training is a developmental process designed to meet requirements described in the ANZPA Training and Standards Manual. Progress is determined by assessment of role development and readiness to commence the next phase of training. Assessment requirements are established with supervisors and trainers at regular intervals throughout the training process.

The aim of training is to bring about an integration of theory and practice through supervised experiential learning of psychodrama, sociodrama, sociometry, role training and group work applied to the trainee's chosen profession or life identity.

Training Hours and Records

A record of completed training is kept for all trainees. A statement of the year's total training hours will be issued to all trainees at the close of the year's training. Trainees can request a printed record for which a fee of \$10 incl. GST is charged.

Library

A range of articles, books and theses may be purchased or borrowed from ATCP. A copy of library operating procedures will be given to trainees on request. Supervision

Supervision is an integral part of the training process and is available individually or in small groups. Supervision with an approved supervisor is credited as training hours.

Policies

If changes are made to the programme, trainees will be notified. If a programme is cancelled, trainees will be refunded in full.

The Privacy Act 1993

ATCP collects, uses and stores the information on the enrolment form according to the principles of the Privacy Act 1993. The information will be used for administration and marketing purposes by ATCP and for the gathering of statistical data.

Foundations and Developing Practice

This year-long programme has been designed for new trainees and those who have done at least one year of psychodrama training. The programme commences with a Friday night and Saturday event and includes 5 Saturday sessions focusing on supervised practice and finishes with a training day. It incorporates two 4 1/2 day psychodrama training workshops, and a 2 day sociodrama training workshop which are also open for others to attend.

The course will build on the cooperative and experiential approach to learning already established in ATCP. Trainees can expect to cover psychodrama curriculum including spontaneity theory, group work, role theory, sociometry. Experience will be built up for application in psychotherapeutic, social, organisational and life settings. Trainees will participate in group interactions and dramatic enactments as audience, protagonist, auxiliary and director.
