

Supervision Training – a two-day Workshop

Friday 30 and Saturday 31 October 2009, Christchurch

This workshop is of value to practitioners who want to develop or enhance their ability as a supervisor. Supervision is a vital part of the ongoing development of counsellors, psychotherapists, mentors, coaches and others. These two days will cover:

- Principles of Supervision
- Experiential exploration of supervision practice
- Discussion and reflection.

In this workshop psychodrama will be used as a *training method*. The focus of the training is supervision practice. Participants can expect to learn more about psychodrama and some techniques they can apply in their work. This supervision training is applicable to each participant's level of experience, modality and profession.

Participation in this workshop will count towards a CITP Certificate in Supervision (details below).

Trainer: Walter Logeman

Walter Logeman is a Psychodramatist and Psychotherapist who works in private practice. He specialises in relationship therapy and supervision. He has a background in teaching and social work and has been a supervisor since the 1980s. Walter is a member of New Zealand Association of Psychotherapists and on the local and national Supervision committee. He is a Trainer Educator Practitioner (in training) in the Australian and New Zealand Psychodrama Association Inc.

About the CITP Certificate in Supervision

The Christchurch Institute for Training in Psychodrama is developing a Certificate in Supervision and offers a training course in Supervision covering the principles of supervision that apply in all professions. CITP course aims provide for comprehensive development of theory and practice including a systems perspective. The certificate will mark a practitioner as an adequate supervisor in their profession. The course is based on a curriculum developed by trainers in the CITP and will consist of experiential workshops, writing assignments and supervision of supervision.

The course is open to people who are qualified and who have practiced for more than one year in a field where supervision or group supervision is applicable.
