Format for a peer group report

- 1. The first area of the report is an objective description of what is said and done in the session. This description is not mixed with interpretation, analysis or evaluation.
- 2. The second area is a report of the process of the session and relationship systems using the language and concepts of role theory, sociometry and group work, as these relate to what you expect to be your area of specialisation. Ideally, you'll focus on an aspect that we are working on in training at the time, e.g. the topic of the most recent training course.
- 3. The third area of the report is a presentation about your directorial functioning showing adequate self-reflection, systemic analysis, and indicating ways in which you would correct and improve your functioning as a director in the future.
