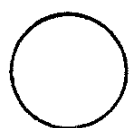

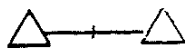


Indicates Female

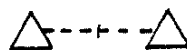

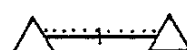

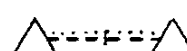

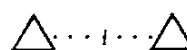

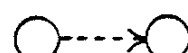

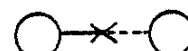

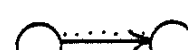
Positive Choice Met with Neutral Response



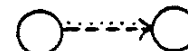
Negative Choice Met with Neutral Response



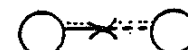
Positive Choice Met with Negative Response



Perceived Positive-Neutral Incongruity

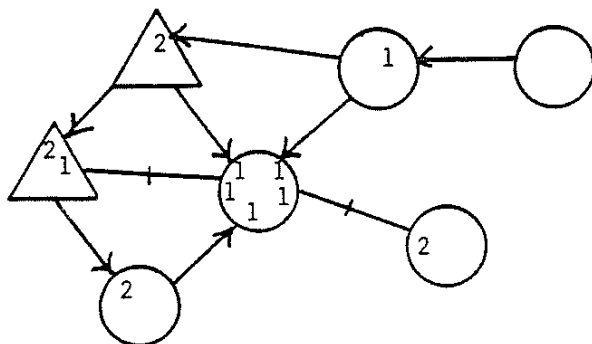


Perceived Negative-Neutral Incongruity
